Try these newspaper databases:

- American Periodicals Series Online
Digitized images of the pages of historic American newspapers.
- LexisNexis Academic
Newspapers, magazines, wire services, federal and state court opinions, federal and state statutes, federal regulations, and SEC filings. News information is updated daily and wire services several times daily.
- Newspaper Source
Newspaper Source contains selected full text for regional U.S. newspapers, international newspapers, newswires, and cover-to-cover full text for *The Christian Science Monitor* and *The Los Angeles Times*.
- SIRS Knowledge Source
Full-text articles on social, scientific, health, historic, business, economic, political and global issues. Articles are selected from more than 1,500 newspapers, magazines, journals, and government publications.
- TOPICsearch
Social, political and economic issues, scientific discoveries, and other popular topics discussed in today's classrooms. Full text for articles from magazines, newspapers, pamphlets, biographies, book reviews, public opinion polls, and government information.
