## Getting a library card

- Obtain a student ID card and barcode number from the Registrar's Office in Rhodes Hall (call 937-328-6015)
- Come to the library to activate the barcode. The barcode remains active as long as you are enrolled in classes.
- For online learners who cannot be on campus during regular business hours, call the library (937-328-6022). A barcode number will be e-mailed to you and an online learner library card will be mailed to you.

## Remote access to library

Searching for materials at Clark State:

- Log on to <http://lib2.clarkstate.edu/>
- Click on the "Catalogs" button to search by title, author or keyword.
- Come to the library and check out materials.

Requesting materials through OhioLINK, the statewide database linking more than 85 college and university libraries in Ohio:

- Log on to the OhioLINK, <http://www.ohiolink.edu/> and choose "OhioLINK Library Catalog. Search for materials.
- Follow onscreen instructions to request materials.
- Materials may be delivered to Clark State or any other OhioLINK library
- Visit any OhioLINK library and borrow items using your Clark State ID and barcode.
- Use your CSCC barcode to connect to OhioLINK databases to find online articles.
- Non-Ohio residents: Your local public library may be able to obtain items for your research. Some colleges and university libraries offer community borrower cards for a fee.

## Books

Authors Last name, First name. Title of Book. Place of publication: Publisher, date of publication.

Example:

Posner, Helaine. Kiki Smith. New York: Monacelli Press, 2005.

## Magazines

Author's Last name, First name. "Article Title." Magazine Title day Month year: page numbers.

Example:

Levy, Steven. "The Future of Reading." Newsweek 26 November 2007: 56-64.

## Journals

Author's Last name, First name. "Article Title." Journal Title volume:issue [note: only include issue when the journal is not continuously paginated throughout the year] (year): page numbers.

Example:

Nistor, A.P. and J. Lowenberg-DeBoer. "Drainage water management impact on farm profitability." Journal of Soil and Water Conservation 62 (2007): 443-446.

## Articles from a database

Author's Last name, First name. "Article Title." Journal Title volume:issue [if required] (year): page numbers or length of article. Name of Database. Name of Library. Day Month year accessed <web address of database or search page>.

Example:

Marshall, Ann, Vicki Burns, and Judi Briden. "Know Your Students." Library Journal 132:18 (2007): 26-29. Academic Search Complete. Clark State Community College Library. 26 November 2007 <lib2.clarkstate.edu/library/referene.html>.

## Websites

Author [individual, company, association, etc.] of website, if given. Title of Website. Day Month year site was last updated, if given. Group responsible/Publisher, if given. Day Month year accessed. <web address>.

Example:

Ohio.gov. 23 November 2007. State of Ohio. 26 November 2007. <www.ohio.gov>.
