Finding articles

OhioLINK offers access to full-text journal, magazine and newspaper articles. To find articles by subject area, go to <http://www.ohiolink.edu> and click on databases “listed by subject”. Select “Medicine and Health” or “Nursing” and click on the title of the database to connect.

To find a specific database, click on databases “listed by name” then click on the title of the database to connect.

To find a specific journal, click on “Electronic Journal Center” and search by journal title or journal subject.

Finding books

Clark State Library Online Catalog

Go to <http://lib2.clarkstate.edu> or “Library” quick link from <http://www.clarkstate.edu> and select “catalogs”. Search by keyword or select title, author, or subject. Examples of subjects include: Nurse Practitioner, Nursing, Patient Education, etc.

OhioLINK – Online catalog for all Ohio colleges and universities

Go to <http://www.ohiolink.edu> and select “OhioLINK Library Catalog”. Search by keyword or select title, author, or subject.

To access full-text reference books via OhioLINK, go to <http://www.ohiolink.edu> and click on “Electronic Books Center”. Select a subject or search by keyword.

APA Citation Style at a glance

Books

Author's Last Name, First letter of first name. (date of publication). Title of book. City of publication: Publisher.

- Example: Myers, D. (1990). *Exploring psychology*. New York: Worth Publishers.

Magazines

Author's Last Name, First letter of first name. (Year of publication, month and day of publication). Article title. *Magazine title*, page numbers.

- Example: Clark, K. (2007, November 5). Heading back to college. *U.S. News and World Report*, 68-73.

Journals

Author's Last Name, First letter of first name. (Year). Article title. *Journal Title*, Volume number [note: when paginated by issue, include issue number in parentheses after the volume number. Do not italicize the issue number], page numbers.

- Example: Fox, C. Brain awareness day: a service-learning experience in neuroscience. *Journal of College Science Teaching*, 37 (2), 40-45.

Articles from a database

Author's Last Name, First letter of first name. (Year). Article title. *Journal Title*, Volume number [note: when paginated by issue, include issue number in parentheses after the volume number. Do not italicize the issue number], page numbers. Date retrieved, name of the database, and document number [if applicable].

- Example: Leventhal, H., Musumeci, T. J., & Leventhal, E. A. (2006). Psychological approaches to the connection of health and behavior. *South African Journal of Psychology*, 36 (4), 666-682. Retrieved December 6, 2007, from Academic Search Complete database.

Websites

Author's Last Name, First letter of first name. (Year, Month of publication). Title of website. Month, day, year accessed, web address.

- Example: Heaps, R.A., Lapidus, J.G., & Schwartzbard, R. (2005). Managing traumatic stress: tips for recovering from natural disasters. Retrieved December 6, 2007, from <http://www.apa.org/topics/topicdisasters.html>.
